We have arranged a trip for our Year 5 classes to visit the Redwood Education Centre near Slimbridge on Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> November. We will be focusing on survival skills which will link to this term's topic relating to natural disasters.

The children will be leaving the school at 9.15am and returning by 3pm. Travel will be by coach and all the children will need to be dressed in old clothes with a waterproof coat and wellies in a separate carrier bag. They will also need to bring a packed lunch and a drink. If your child receives free school meals then the kitchen can provide a packed lunch, you just need to supply your child with a drink. Please tick the box on the return slip if you would like a packed lunch provided.

We would kindly ask that all parents make a voluntary contribution of £4 per child. We have kept the costs to a minimum but we will still need sufficient contributions from the parents in order for the trip to go ahead or it will be cancelled.

For your information, Insurance by the County Council covers the legal liability of the Council to young people on the visit and provides personal accident cover during the visit should it be needed but we hope not.
