Year 3 Trip to Coaley Peak – Wednesday 8th January 2020

We have arranged a trip for our Year 3 children to visit Coaley Peak on Wednesday 8th January 2020. This is to let the children view the geographical features - principally the valley created by the River Severn and will be linked to next term's topic of Amazing Spaces and Places.

The children will be leaving the school by 9.00am and returning by 12pm in time for lunch. Travel will be by coach and all the children will need to wear warm clothing, not uniform and bring wellies in a bag. Please ensure your child has a waterproof coat, hat, ear muffs, scarf, gloves etc as the weather on the top of the hill can be extremely windy, wet and cold at this time of year. The children will be walking around at the site.

The children will be back in time for lunch. We would kindly ask that all parents make a voluntary contribution of £3 per child which covers the coach fare to and from the site. We have kept the cost of the trip as low as possible but we will need sufficient contributions from the parents in order for the trip to go ahead.

A system of emergency contact will be arranged. Please complete and return the reply slip below and your payment by Thursday 19th December.

For your information, Insurance by the County Council covers the legal liability of the Council to young people on the visit and provides personal accident cover during the visit should it be needed but we hope not.
