From next week we will be focusing on counting in 2's. Please practise answering times tables at random. The questions are in this format if you would like to practise with them:

$3 \times 2 =$

$11 \times 5 =$

$4 \times 10 =$

Over the course of this term, please choose 4 activities from the grid below, to complete. When you have completed an activity, colour in the rectangle on the grid and ask your parent to sign and date when you completed it. Please add a photo to Tapestry. The 4 longer activities can be handed in by Thursday 19th December 2019.

<p>Create a wintery picture. You can use any resources or techniques you choose.</p> <p>You could sketch, paint, or make a collage using different materials or using natural materials outside.</p> <p>Take a photo of your finished work and put on Tapestry or bring it into class to display.</p>	<p>Can you take a photo of a pet or favourite animal? Practice speaking in clear and full sentences about it. Ask a family member to film you talking about your animal and put the video on Tapestry. Or, you could bring in your photo into school and talk to the class about it.</p>	<p>Practise different ways of making the number 10. You could have 6 colouring pencils and then find how many more you need to add to make 10. Practise recording this as $6 + 4 = 10$.</p> <p>You can use all sorts of objects to help you around your house or out and about with leaves, stones etc.</p>
<p>Primary Talk- Practise sharing stories about something that has happened during your day/week. Ideas could include a something we have done in school or something good that happened at work. Include key features such as who, when, where and what. For example, "Last night, I went to the cinema with my friend Sam and we watched a funny film."</p>	<p>Talk about seasonal changes with your grown up. Compare your Autumnal walk with a frosty weekend adventure in your garden or elsewhere. What do you notice about the leaves/trees? What you are wearing? Talk about the evenings getting darker. What is frost? Is it still there at different times of the day? Why?</p>	<p>Write a letter to Father Christmas. Make a list of the things you would like. Can you use adjectives to give Father Christmas more details? Don't forget our Every Time We Write rules:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Finger spaces -Words on the line -Capital letters and full stops.
